AN AMENDMENT to Article 59-H, title "Amendment procedures," Division 59-H-2, title "Map Amendments--Applications," Sections 59-H-2.4, title "Contents of Application--Local Map Amendments," 59-H-2.4A, title "Optional Method of Application for Local Map Amendment," and 59-H-2.5, title "Contents of Application--Sectional and District Map Amendment," redesignating titles and renumbering sections to specify the two alternative methods that exist for local map amendments, and for the purpose of expanding the Optional Method of Application to all Floating Zones that do not require the filing of a development plan and for the purpose of clarifying, reorganizing, and further specifying the existing requirements and administrative practices pertaining to the submission and approval of Optional Method applications.

AN AMENDMENT to Section 59-C-9, title "Rural Zone," Subsection 59-C-9.1, title "Land Uses," and to Section 59-C-11, title "Rural Density Transfer Zone," Subsection 59-C-11.1, title "Land Uses," to allow by Special Exception, group residential facilities for not more than 8 developmentally disabled persons, and by Permitted Use, group residential facilities for housing exceptional persons, in the Rural Zone and the Rural Density Transfer Zone.
