H.B. 113-Apprenticeship and Training Council - Continue the existence of the Council by extending to a certain date the termination provisions10 (14)

H.B. 120-State Board of Examiners for Audiologists - Continue the existence of the Board by extending to a certain date the termination provisions11 (15)

H.B. 121-State Board of Electrologists - Continue the existence of the Board by extending to a certain date the termination provisions12 (16)

H.B. 123-Board of Examiners for Hearing Aid Dealers - Continue the existence of the Board by extending the termination provisions 13 (17)

H.B. 125-State Board of Examiners for Speech Pathologists - Continue the existence of the Board by extending to a certain date the termination provisions14 (18)

H.B. 226-Retail sales tax - Create an exemption from the retail sales tax for sales of diesel fuel for the reclamation of certain land that has been mined for coal by certain methods15 (19)

H.B. 239-State Board of Law Examiners - Continue the existence of the Board by extending to a certain date the termination provisions16 (20)

H.B. 314-Natural resources - Allow certain legally constituted authorities in Maryland to pursue certain persons who commit certain offenses on the waters of the State of Maryland across the border into the Commonwealth of Virginia and vice versa17 (21)

H.B. 315-Fishing and crabbing - Require the Department of Natural Resources to assess a nonresident a certain surcharge on the issuance of certain fishing and crabbing licenses and relating thereto19 (22)

H.B. 340-Handgun violations - Increase the maximum penalty for a subsequent offense of a handgun in the commission of a crime20 (23)

H.B. 461-Wrongful Death Act - Clarify that damages may be recovered by or for a legitimate or illegitimate child and provide that parents may recover certain damages for the death of an unmarried child who is not a minor under certain circumstances21 (24)

H.B. 496-Garrett County - Alter the annual license fee for pinball machines and certain other coin operated amusement devices22 (25)

H.B. 590-Belair Mansion Loan of 1983 - Create a State Debt of \$500,000 to be used as a grant to the City of Bowie for restoration and improvement of the Belair Mansion23 (26)

H.B. 604-Chiropractors - Permit the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners to deny, suspend or revoke a license, and reprimand a licensee, for failure to file or record certain reports, providing professional services under the influence of certain substances or practicing chiropractic in a certain manner24 (27)
