(b) Items 2C and 3A of the Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation Commission dated January 11, 2006, shall be void and provisions related to the allowance for in-district travel and the retirement benefits available to legislators in the Legislative Pension Plan shall be as provided in the Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation Commission dated January 11, 2002; and

(c) The other items related to compensation and allowances to members of the General Assembly shall be as provided in the Resolution of the General Assembly Compensation Commission dated January 11, 2006; and be it further
