Bill No. 05-02

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 109-8, Solid waste management plan, of Article I, General Provisions, of Chapter 109, Environmental Control, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for the adoption of a revised January 2005 Solid Waste Management Plan governing all aspects of solid waste for Harford County; to provide that the County may change the Plan by resolution adopted by the County Council if the Maryland Department of the Environment disapproves of or requires changes to any part of the Plan; and generally relating to the Solid Waste Management Plan.

Bill No. 05-03 As Amended

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 267-49, Housing for the elderly, of Article VII, Design Standards for Special Developments, of Part 1, Standards, of Chapter 267, Zoning, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for minimum conditions and covenants regarding age restrictions; and generally relating to housing for the elderly.

Bill No. 05-11

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection A of Section 267-60.1, Preservation of historic property, of Article X, General Provisions, of Part 2, Historic District, of Chapter 267, Zoning, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for the addition of the Stone House and Spring House of Edgeley Grove Farm to the list of county-owned historic property.

Bill No. 05-12

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection J of Section 256-13, Water and Sewer Plan, of Article I, General Provisions, of Chapter 256, Water and Sewers, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for the adoption of the Spring 2005 Master Water and Sewer Plan and to submit said Plan to the Maryland Department of the Environment for its approval and implementation pursuant to Title 9 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Annotated Code.
