

(B) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS AND A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$25 LESS THAN \$500.

(2) EACH DAY ON WHICH A VIOLATION CONTINUES IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

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**CHAPTER 375**

**(House Bill 458)**

AN ACT concerning

**Health Insurance - Coverage for Psychological and Neuropsychological Testing**

FOR the purpose of providing that health insurance coverage, including coverage provided by a health maintenance organization, is not discriminatory if, with respect to outpatient coverage for services provided to treat mental illnesses, emotional disorders, drug abuse, or alcohol abuse, benefits include psychological and neuropsychological testing for diagnostic purposes; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to health insurance coverage for psychological and neuropsychological testing for diagnostic purposes.
