(A) Public School Construction Program. Provide funds to construct public school buildings and public school capital improvements in accordance with Sections 5-301 through 5-303 of the Education Article, ~~provided that, notwithstanding Section 5-302(c) of the Education Article or any other provision of law, the Interagency Committee on School Construction shall, in accordance with the provisions below, allocate 100% of the funds available for public school construction projects in fiscal year 2006.
