The committee has the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your report of the 15th inst. and in reply to inform you that the same has been forwarded to the several Tobacco Warehouses under the supervision of the several Inspectors, such as repairing roofs, spouting, flooring, windows, and joists, &c., which repairs are deemed necessary for the preservation of the houses and the tobacco therein contained.

Your committee recommend an increase of pay to the laborers in the Tobacco Warehouses, say an advance of fifty cents per laborer per day.

Your committee herewith submit a statement from each of the Inspectors on their affairs, and ask that the same be printed with this report.
