On motion of Mr. Poteet,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to charter a company to build a railroad from Baltimore city through Baltimore and Harford counties, to connect with the Baltimore and Philadelphia Central Rail Road on the Susquehanna River.

On motion of Mr. Nairne,

Leave was granted the Worcester county delegation to report a bill authorizing the Register of Wills, and the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Worcester county, to have certain books of record indexed, and to cause a sum of money to be levied on the taxable property of said county, to pay for the same.
