Said bill was then sent to the Senate.

The hour of 12 M. having arrived, the Honorable, the Speaker, announced,

The bill entitled, An act for the relief of the families of the Maryland Volunteers;

As the Order of the Day;

Pending its second reading,

Mr. Magruder proposed the following:

Section 4, strike out all after the word "necessary," in the 6th line to the end of the 7th line;

Section 4, strike out all after the word "week," in the 13th line, and insert:

"Provided, That in no case shall the whole amount to be expended for any one family, including wife and children and mother and sisters, exceed the sum of ten dollars per month;

Which were rejected.

Mr. Gunby proposed the following:

Strike out the word "fourteen," in lines 4, 9 and 11, section 4, and in lines 7 and 9, section 5, and insert in lieu thereof the word "twelve;"

Which was adopted.

Mr. Leckie proposed the following:

Strike out the words "ten," in line 7, section 4, and insert in lieu thereof the word "six;"

Which was rejected.
