Mr. Davis, of Charles, proposed to strike out the words "five hundred," in the 1st section, and insert the words "three hundred," in lieu thereof;

Which was rejected.

Mr. Smyth proposed to strike out the words "three hundred," in the 2nd section, and insert in lieu thereof the words "seven hundred and fifty;"

Mr. Hugg moved to amend by inserting the words "one hundred and fifty;"

Which was rejected.

Mr. Hardcastle moved to amend by inserting the words "five hundred;"

Which was rejected.

The original amendment was then rejected.

Mr. McIntire proposed the following amendment:

4th section, strike out 5th line, and insert, "as counsel for the agent of the State appointed to receive the State arms;"
