#### REPORT :

The committee on Printing beg leave to report that they have agreed to contract with Thomas J. Wilson, of Annapolis, for the printing of five hundred copies of the Journal of Proceedings and accompanying Documents; and one hundred and thirty copies of all Bills and Reports ordered to be printed; as also, all other and further printing that shall be required by this House of Delegates, upon the following terms, to wit :

For the Journal of Proceedings and accompanying Documents, one dollar and forty cents per page of fourteen hundred and fifty ems; for all Bills and Reports, the sum of one dollar per page; and for all tabular work, double the above prices.

The said Thomas J. Wilson, has further stipulated and agreed to furnish daily, in accordance with section 2d, of Article 76, of the Code of Public General Laws, one hundred and thirty copies of the Daily Morning Journal, for which he shall receive no compensation.

And the said Thomas J. Wilson, has further stipulated to execute and furnish all of said printing within thirty days after the adjournment of the General Assembly.
