

Mr. Biggs, from a special committee, reported a bill entitled, An act to authorize David Eyer, of School District, No. 89, in Frederick county, to sell and convey to any purchaser all that lot of land called "Simon's Delight," which was conveyed to him by Catharine Weller, for a site for a school house;

Which was read, and referred to the committee on the Judiciary.

On motion of Mr. Ensor,

The rules were suspended, and leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary, to report a bill to amend the 314th section of article 93 of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to the place of granting letters testamentary or of administration.

Also, leave was granted the Baltimore county delegation, to report a bill to amend the 55, 56 and 57th sections of article 3 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the collection of taxes in Baltimore county.

The bill entitled, An act to amend the 8th section of article 45 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled, Husband and Wife, relating to the insurance of the life of the husband for the use and benefit of the wife;

Was read the second, and by special order, a third time, and passed by yeas and nays as follow:
