

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "motorcycle" by ~~removing the criteria relating to brake horsepower and piston displacement, and providing that a motorcycle is defined as a motor vehicle that is self-propelled by a motor; prohibiting a person from operating certain motorcycles on certain roads; requiring certain motorcycle dealers to inform a buyer of certain motorcycles about the provisions of this Act; repealing a certain section; and allowing the Motor Vehicle Administration to provide certain warnings under this Act.~~

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

11-136.

(a) "Motorcycle" means a motor vehicle that:

(1) Has two wheels;

(2) [~~Has~~] IS SELF-PROPELLED BY a motor with a rating of more than 1.5 brake horsepower and a capacity of ~~more than 50~~ AT LEAST 49 cubic centimeters piston displacement; ~~---IS SELF-PROPELLED BY A MOTOR;~~

(3) Has a singular front steering road wheel mounted in a fork assembly that passes through a frame steering bearing and to which is attached a handlebar or other directly operated steering device;
