[(e)] ~~{H}~~ (F) An award granted under this section:

(1) May be used for:

(i) Tuition and mandatory fees;

(ii) Room and board; and

(iii) Books and supplies; and

(2) May be used at any institution approved by the State Scholarship Board including:

(i) An institution of higher education;

(ii) A vocational school;

(iii) A commercial school; or

(iv) A military preparatory school, if the child is preparing to attend one of the United States military academies.
