

(i) Meets the qualifications otherwise required by this title; and

(ii) Became certified in the other state after passing in that or any other state an examination that is similar to the examination for which the applicant is seeking the waiver.

(c) An agreement may be made with another state under this section only if, under the agreement, the other state waives the examination of registered [sanitarians or sanitarians in training] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH-PRACTITIONERS SANITARIANS of this State to a similar extent as this State waives the examination requirements for individuals certified in that state.

(a) The Board shall certify and issue the appropriate certificate to any applicant who meets the requirements of this title.

(b) The Board shall include on each certificate that it issues:

(1) The designation "registered [sanitarian" or "sanitarian in training"] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH---PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN";

(2) The name of the certificate holder;

(3) The date of issue and serial number of the certificate;

(4) The Board seal; and

(5) The signature of the Board.

(c) The Board shall issue a new certificate to replace a lost, destroyed, or mutilated certificate if the certificate holder pays a fee [of not more than \$25] that is set by the Board.

[(a)] Certification as a registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH--PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN authorizes the registered [sanitarian] ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH---PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN to use the title ["registered sanitarian"] "ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH--PRACTITIONER SANITARIAN" and the initials -{"R.S."-}---"R-E-H-P." after the name of the registered sanitarian while the certification is effective.

[(b)] Certification as a sanitarian in training authorizes the sanitarian in training to use the title "sanitarian in training" while the certification is effective.]
