

CIVIC, NONPROFIT, CHARITABLE, FRATERNAL, PATRIOTIC, EDUCATIONAL, OR PUBLIC SERVICE ORGANIZATION, OR BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS INSTITUTION IN EXISTENCE FOR A MINIMUM OF 3 YEARS.

(2) THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY EXEMPT PLACES SIMILAR TO THOSE LISTED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (iii) OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(2) (1) THE FOLLOWING ARE EXEMPT FROM PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION:

1. THE ROOM OF A REGISTERED GUEST IN A HOTEL, MOTEL, OR HOSPICE; OR

2. THE PROPERTY OF A VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY.

(II) THE FOLLOWING ARE EXEMPT FROM PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION IF THEY HAVE BEEN IN EXISTENCE FOR A MINIMUM OF 3 YEARS:

1. A BONA FIDE CATERING ESTABLISHMENT;

2. A COMMUNITY OR CIVIC ASSOCIATION;

3. A SWIM CLUB;

4. A BONA FIDE SOCIAL, CIVIC, NONPROFIT, CHARITABLE, FRATERNAL, PATRIOTIC, EDUCATIONAL, OR PUBLIC SERVICE ORGANIZATION; OR

5. A BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS INSTITUTION.

(3) THE WORCESTER COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL ADOPT UNIFORM RULES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF EXCEPTIONS SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(4) ANY OWNER, OPERATOR, MANAGER, OR EMPLOYEE OF PREMISES OR PLACES SUBJECT TO THE PROHIBITIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION WHO KNOWINGLY PERMITS CONSUMPTION IN VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1985.
