

(A) THE DIVIDING LINE BETWEEN THE 1ST AND 2ND COUNTY ELECTION DISTRICTS IS A LINE BEGINNING AT THE CONFLUENCE OF BATTLE CREEK AND THE PATUXENT RIVER, AND CONTINUING NORTHEASTWARD ALONG BATTLE CREEK AND THE CYPRESS SWAMP CREEK UP TO THE POINT WHERE CYPRESS SWAMP CREEK PASSES UNDER SIXES ROAD (MD. 506), THEN CONTINUING NORTHEASTWARD ON SIXES ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF SIXES ROAD (MD. 506) AND MD. ROUTE 2/4, THEN CONTINUING NORTHEASTWARD IN A STRAIGHT LINE TO A POINT ON PARKER'S CREEK 1-3/10 MILES FROM THE CHESAPEAKE BAY, THEN ALONG PARKER'S CREEK TO THE CHESAPEAKE BAY; AND

(B) THE DIVIDING LINE BETWEEN THE 2ND AND 3RD COUNTY ELECTION DISTRICTS IS A LINE BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE PATUXENT RIVER AT THE END OF DEEP LANDING ROAD-- --, THEN ALONG DEEP LANDING ROAD TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH MD. ROUTE 521, THEN CONTINUING NORTHEASTWARD ALONG HUNTING CREEK ROAD (MD. 521) TO THE INTERSECTION AT ROUTE 524, THEN NORTHWARD ON RT. 524 TO MD. ROUTE 2/4-- --, THEN NORTHWARD ON MD. ROUTE 2/4 TO THE INTERSECTION OF MD. ROUTE 2/4 AND POND WOODS ROAD-- --, THEN EASTWARD ON POND WOODS ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF MD. RT. 261-- --, THEN NORTHEASTWARD ON MD. RT. 261 TO THE SOUTHWESTERNMOST POINT OF THE SUBDIVISION KNOWN AS CAMP ROOSEVELT-- --, THEN FOLLOWING THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY LINE OF CAMP ROOSEVELT SUBDIVISION TO THE CHESAPEAKE BAY.

## TITLE 2. COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

### SUBTITLE 1. GENERALLY.

#### 2-101. NUMBER; COMPENSATION.

FIVE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COMPRISE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CALVERT COUNTY. THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD IS \$18,000, AND THE ANNUAL SALARY OF EACH OF THE ASSOCIATE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD IS \$15,000.

#### 2-102. COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS.

BEGINNING WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN CALVERT COUNTY IN NOVEMBER, 1978, 5 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL BE ELECTED BY COUNTYWIDE VOTE. ONE SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THE FIRST ELECTION DISTRICT, 1 A RESIDENT OF THE SECOND ELECTION DISTRICT, AND 1 A RESIDENT OF THE THIRD ELECTION DISTRICT OF THE COUNTY. OF THE REMAINING CANDIDATES, THE 2 RECEIVING THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES SHALL BE SELECTED. COMMISSIONERS WHO ARE ELECTED AND QUALIFY SHALL TAKE OFFICE THE THIRD TUESDAY OF DECEMBER FOLLOWING ELECTION. EACH COMMISSIONER SHALL HOLD OFFICE FOR 4 YEARS OR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIED.

#### 2-103. PRESIDENT.

THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AT THEIR FIRST MEETING AFTER THEIR ELECTION AND QUALIFICATION, SHALL ELECT BY A MAJORITY VOTE ONE OF THEIR NUMBER TO BE THEIR PRESIDENT. THE PRESIDENT SHALL SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIED.
