A House Joint Resolution concerning

Disabled Persons - Program Expansion - Fiscal Plan

FOR the purpose of requesting the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning to develop and submit to the General Assembly by a certain date a 5-year plan, beginning with fiscal year 1986, ~~to secure the necessary fiscal resources to~~ year 1987, to identify the level of fiscal resources necessary to implement certain plans for program expansion of services to the ~~retarded~~ mentally retarded and nonretarded developmentally disabled.

WHEREAS, There are 2400 mentally retarded and 1100 nonretarded developmentally disabled people on the waiting list for community-based residential and day programs funded by the Mental Retardation Developmental Disabilities Administration, (MRDDA); and
