 have his body before the Justices of our next County Court to be held at our
 house in the Town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday in June
 next to satisfy unto George Hill of Kent County Shipcarpenter the Sum of
 two hundred and thirty two pounds of Tobacco then to be recovered
 by the Considerations of the Justices of our said Court the Twenty fourth day
 of this Instant March whereof he will Convoit as appears upon Record together
 with the Sum of forty six pounds of Tobacco & on this present thereof
 will not at your perill and have you then in shew this writ with all
 Harris Gent Justice of our said Court the 24 day of March in the first
 year of our Dominion &c Anno Domini 1776
 Norman & Hills

At which said next Court viz. this nineteenth day of June Anno Domini
 one Thousand Seven hundred and Seventeen the day of return of said writ came
 William Frisby Gentleman High Sheriff of said County and made Return
 thereof in these words thereon endorsed as follows
