

(f) (1) Except in accordance with a proper judicial order and except by request of an officer of this county or municipality OR THE MARYLAND SPORTS STADIUM AUTHORITY having a right to make the request in an official capacity, an official or employee of the State or any of its subdivisions may not make known in any manner any information contained in any report filed under § 405 of this article.

(2) Nothing contained in this section shall prohibit the publication of statistics so classified as to prevent identification of individual accounts.

(g) A violation of subsection (f) of this section is a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 6 months, or both.
