CHAPTER 484

(House Bill 697)

AN ACT concerning

State Public Education Aid

FOR the purpose of altering the eligibility requirements under which a county receives State public education aid; requiring that the State Superintendent establish procedures for determining whether a county is in compliance with the provisions of this Act; ~~altering--certain--penalties; redistributing--certain--funds--to-counties-that-comply-with the-provisions-of-this-Act; making--this--Act--an--emergency measure;~~ and generally relating to State public education aid and measures to provide accountability for its expenditures.
