

(1) 2 members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House;

(2) 2 members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of the Senate;

(3) 2 public school teachers, appointed by the Governor;

(4) 2 members of local boards of education appointed by the Governor;

(5) 1 member who is a local superintendent of schools;

(6) 1 member who is a member of the State Board of Education;

(7) The State Superintendent of Schools; and

(8) 4 members of the public including representation from the business community, appointed by the Governor; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Governor is requested to provide appropriate staff resources to serve the Commission; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Commission make a final report to the Governor and to the General Assembly on or before ~~October 15,~~ ~~1986~~ January 1, 1987, and be it further
