RESOLUTION NO. R-6-85

Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Somerset adopted pursuant to the authority of Article XI-E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland to amend Section 83-29 of the Charter of the Town of Somerset as it appears in the Montgomery County Code (1972) so as to change the date for the election of the Mayor and Councilmen from the first Monday in May of every year to the first Monday in April of every year, beginning with the elections to be held from and after April 7, 1986.
