CHAPTER 218

(House Bill 406)

AN ACT concerning

Kent County - Alcoholic Beverages License Fee

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Kent County Board of License Commissioners to grant a refund to an alcoholic beverage licensee who surrenders the license to the Board before the expiration date of the license; providing for the basis and calculation of the refund; authorizing the Board to prorate the fee of a license that is issued for a period less than the full renewal period; providing the basis for a prorated fee; providing that this Act does not have a retroactive effect; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages license fees in Kent County.

BY adding to

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
Section 64(g)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1981 Replacement Volume and 1986 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

64.

(G) (1) (I) IF A HOLDER OF A KENT COUNTY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE VOLUNTARILY SURRENDERS THE LICENSE BEFORE ITS EXPIRATION DATE, THE KENT COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL GRANT A REFUND:

1. BASED ON THE NUMBER OF WHOLE MONTHS REMAINING BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRATION DATE; AND

2. CALCULATED AS 1/12 OF 95 PERCENT OF THE LICENSE FEE PAID FOR EACH WHOLE MONTH REMAINING BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRATION DATE.
