

(2) A LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE WATER IS IN ANY WAY INJURIOUS TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH.

(B) (1) ANY PERSON WHO HANDLES DRINKING WATER SHIPPED FROM POINTS OUTSIDE THIS STATE SHALL RECEIVE A REGISTRATION TO SELL WATER ONLY IF THE PERSON PRESENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT A STATEMENT OF ACCEPTABILITY ISSUED BY THE APPROPRIATE APPROVING AUTHORITY OF THE STATE IN WHICH THE WATER IS COLLECTED, DEMONSTRATING THAT THE SOURCE OF THE WATER SUPPLY AND THE METHOD OF HANDLING THE WATER, AS PRACTICED IN THAT STATE, ARE NOT PREJUDICIAL TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH, AND THAT THE WATER IS ALLOWED TO BE SOLD IN THE STATE THAT ISSUED THE LICENSE.

(2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PREVENT THE DEPARTMENT FROM PROHIBITING THE USE OF WATER SHIPPED FROM OUTSIDE THIS STATE, IF, IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT, THE WATER IS SHOWN BY ANALYSIS TO BE UNFIT FOR DRINKING OR IF ITS QUALITY IN ANY WAS WAY IS INJURED BY SUCH HANDLING AS MAY BE ACCORDED TO IT AFTER ARRIVING IN THIS STATE.

(C) DRINKING WATER PACKAGED AND SOLD IN THIS STATE IN INDIVIDUAL CONTAINERS MADE OF PAPER OR PLASTIC-COATED PAPER SHALL BE MARKED WITH A STENCIL OR STAMP CLEARLY INDICATING THE MONTH AND DAY THE WATER WAS PLACED IN THE CONTAINER.

(A) EACH CONTAINER OF CRAB MEAT SHALL BE MARKED PLAINLY WITH THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

(B) (1) EACH CONTAINER OF CRAB MEAT SHALL BE MARKED BY:

(I) EMBOSSING;

(II) IMPRINTING;

(III) LITHOGRAPHY; OR

(IV) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ANY OTHER METHOD THAT THE DEPARTMENT APPROVES.

(2) UNLESS APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY, A CONTAINER OF CRAB MEAT MAY NOT BE STAMPED WITH INK.

(C) (1) EACH CONTAINER OF CRAB MEAT SHALL BE MARKED WITH:
