CHAPTER 299

(House Bill 1093)

AN ACT concerning

Physicians - Education on Breast Implantation

FOR the purpose of requiring physicians to educate inform certain patients in a certain manner of the advantages, disadvantages, and risks associated with breast implantations; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to provide a standardized written summary containing certain information about breast implantation; ~~providing--a penalty-for-failure-to-educate-a-breast-implantation-patient of--the-advantages,-disadvantages,-and-risks-associated-with breast-implantation;~~ making the provisions of this Act supplemental and additional to any requirement now existing upon a physician; providing for a certain effective date; and generally relating to breast implantation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
