House Bill No. 584

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Driver License Compact

FOR the purpose of providing for the State of Maryland to enter into a certain driver license compact with other jurisdictions in the United States; providing for the reporting and effect of certain convictions; prohibiting the Administration from assessing points against an individual under certain circumstances; requiring the Administration to assess points against an individual under certain circumstances; prohibiting issuance of a driver's license under certain circumstances; providing for the applicability of certain other laws; providing that the Motor Vehicle Administrator shall be the administrator of the provisions of the compact; providing procedures for entering into force, or withdrawing from, the compact; providing for the construction of the compact and for the implementation of this Act; providing for reimbursement of certain expenses of the Administrator; providing for certain judicial review of certain acts or omissions; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the adoption of a driver license compact.
