

(3) Encourage development of recreational areas and encourage tourist business in the county, making the public aware of the county's historical background and progress;

(4) Disseminate information in the interest of industrial and business development by publication, advertising and other means;

(5) Cooperate with any federal, state, local agency, board or commission, including the Maryland Department of Economic and [Community] EMPLOYMENT Development, in the furtherance of its purposes;

(6) Cooperate with any interested private concern, civic organization or subdivision thereof in furtherance of its purposes; and

(7) Establish and appoint Advisory Groups and Committees to assist in its program of activity, the membership of which is not restricted to members of the Commission.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1988.

CHAPTER 46

(Senate Bill 694)

AN ACT concerning

Sheriffs - Harford County - Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Harford County; and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary of the incumbent Sheriff of Harford County.
