SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

18-213.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

[(1)] ~~{7}~~- (II) Hepatitis B;

[(2)] ~~{8}~~- (III) Meningococcal meningitis;

[(3)] ~~{9}~~- (IV) Tuberculosis;

[(4)] ~~{10}~~- (V) Malaria;

[(5)] ~~{11}~~- (VI) Rabies; or

[(6)] ~~{12}~~- (VII) Mononucleosis.

(3) "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO, IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY, IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO MAKE ARRESTS AND WHO IS A MEMBER OF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES:

(I) THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE;

(II) THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT;

(III) THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, BUREAU, OR FORCE
