THE SUPERINTENDENT MAY NOT ISSUE A LICENSE TO AN APPLICANT WHOSE TRADE OR FICTITIOUS NAME OR TRADEMARK IS SO SIMILAR TO THAT USED BY ANOTHER LICENSEE THAT THE PUBLIC MAY BE CONFUSED OR MISLED BY THE SIMILARITY.

13-306. ISSUANCE AND CONTENTS OF LICENSE.

(A) ISSUANCE.

(1) THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) THE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL ISSUE AN AGENCY LICENSE CERTIFICATE TO EACH LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY AND A BRANCH OFFICE CERTIFICATE FOR EACH PROPOSED BRANCH OFFICE.
