

INDIVIDUAL FOR HIRE AS A SECURITY GUARD ONLY IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS CERTIFIED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT AS A PRIVATE DETECTIVE OR AS A SECURITY GUARD.

(2) A LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY MAY PROVIDE AN UNCERTIFIED INDIVIDUAL FOR HIRE AS A SECURITY GUARD IF:

(I) THE PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY HAS SUBMITTED TO THE SUPERINTENDENT THE APPLICATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL FOR CERTIFICATION AS A SECURITY GUARD, FINGERPRINT CARDS, AND RECORDS FEE AS REQUIRED UNDER § 13-502(B) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(II) THE SUPERINTENDENT HAS NOT DISAPPROVED THE APPLICATION.

13-502. QUALIFICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATION; APPLICATION.

(A) QUALIFICATIONS.

TO QUALIFY FOR CERTIFICATION AS A SECURITY GUARD, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL:

- (1) MEET THE STANDARDS SET BY THE SUPERINTENDENT;
- (2) BE AN EMPLOYEE OF OR AN APPLICANT FOR EMPLOYMENT WITH A LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY;
- (3) SUBMIT TO THE LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY, FOR FORWARDING TO THE SUPERINTENDENT:

(I) A SWORN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THE SUPERINTENDENT PROVIDES; AND

(II) 2 SETS OF FINGERPRINT CARDS MARKED WITH THE APPLICANT'S FINGERPRINTS; AND

(4) PAY TO THE LICENSED PRIVATE DETECTIVE AGENCY, FOR FORWARDING TO THE SUPERINTENDENT, A RECORDS FEE SET BY THE SUPERINTENDENT, NOT TO EXCEED THE FEE THAT THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION CHARGES THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE FOR A FINGERPRINT CARD RECORD CHECK.
