

(2) SHALL HAVE:

(I) BEEN GRADUATED FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY ON COMPLETION OF AN UNAPPROVED CURRICULUM, AS REQUIRED UNDER § 15-305(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(II) COMPLETED AT LEAST 4 OF THE 6 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE REQUIRED UNDER § 15-305(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) APPLICATION.

(1) AN APPLICANT FOR EARLY EXAMINATION SHALL:

(I) SUBMIT TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD PROVIDES; AND

(II) PAY TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE OF \$10.

(2) THE PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE APPLICATION SHALL BE THE SAME AS PROVIDED UNDER § 15-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

(D) RIGHT TO EXAMINATION.

AN APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION IS ENTITLED TO TAKE THE FUNDAMENTALS OF LAND SURVEYING EXAMINATION.

(E) PASSAGE OF EXAMINATION.

IF AN INDIVIDUAL PASSES A FUNDAMENTALS OF LAND SURVEYING EXAMINATION UNDER THIS SECTION, THE BOARD:

(1) FOR A PERIOD OF 10 YEARS, SHALL CONSIDER THE PASSAGE AS VALID FOR PURPOSES OF MEETING THE LICENSE QUALIFICATIONS SET FORTH UNDER § 15-305(B) AND (C) OF THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) SHALL KEEP A RECORD THAT THE INDIVIDUAL PASSED THE EXAMINATION; AND

(3) SHALL ISSUE TO THE INDIVIDUAL A CERTIFICATE THAT STATES THAT THE INDIVIDUAL PASSED THE EXAMINATION AND THAT SETS FORTH:

(I) THE FULL NAME OF THE INDIVIDUAL;

(II) THE TERMINATION DATE OF THE CERTIFICATE, AS PROVIDED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION;

(III) THE CERTIFICATE NUMBER ASSIGNED BY THE BOARD TO THE INDIVIDUAL; AND
