

(g) The Department of Juvenile Services is responsible for the collection of restitution payments when the restitution order provides that restitution is to be made in periodic or installment payments, as part of probation, or pursuant to a work plan.

(A) IN A RESTITUTION HEARING HELD UNDER § 3-829 OF THIS ARTICLE OR ARTICLE 27, § 640 OF THE CODE, A WRITTEN STATEMENT OR BILL FOR MEDICAL, DENTAL, HOSPITAL, FUNERAL, OR BURIAL EXPENSES SHALL BE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE THAT THE AMOUNT INDICATED ON THE WRITTEN STATEMENT OR BILL REPRESENTS A FAIR, ~~REASONABLE, AND NECESSARY~~ AND REASONABLE CHARGE FOR THE SERVICES OR MATERIALS PROVIDED.

(B) THE BURDEN OF PROVING THAT THE AMOUNT INDICATED ON THE WRITTEN STATEMENT OR BILL IS NOT FAIR, ~~REASONABLE, OR NECESSARY~~ AND REASONABLE SHALL BE ON THE PERSON CHALLENGING THE FAIRNESS, ~~REASONABLENESS, OR NECESSITY~~ AND REASONABLENESS OF THE AMOUNT.

**(Senate Bill 275)**

AN ACT concerning

**Diamondback Terrapin - State Reptile and Mascot of University of Maryland College Park**
