 the sealing and delivery of these presents to the in and to the effect  
 whereof the said John L. Jones do hereby acknowledge have  
 granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do hereby  
 grant bargain and sell unto the said Wm M Edmundson his  
 Executors, administrators and assigns all the property here  
 in after particular mentioned that is to say, One Bay or  
 Brown Horse, one bay mare, one small Colt one yoke of oxen  
 One or east Two Miled Cows Two Heifers Two yearlings &  
 All and singular which said goods and chattels are  
 now remaining and being in a certain Messuage or  
 tenement situated on Cabins Creek and now in the  
 Occupation of the said John L. Jones. To have and to  
 hold all and singular of the said property aforesaid bargained  
 and sold or mentioned written deed to be to the  
 said Wm M Edmundson his Executors administrators  
 or assigns forever; and I the said John L. Jones for myself  
 my heirs Executors and administrators all and  
 singular the said property unto the said Wm M Edmundson  
 and his Executors administrators and assigns against  
 me the said John L. Jones my Executors and administrators  
 and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever
