Sealed with our Seals and dated this twenty fifth day of June in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight Hundred and forty nine. The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bounden John Richardson appointed Collector of Dorchester County shall faithfully collect and pay the Sum of Three Hundred and ^{Sixty} Six Dollars and Thirty three Cents Current Money of the United States into the Treasury of the State of Maryland over before the first day of July Eighteen Hundred and fifty to and for the use of the State, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and Virtue in Law.
