

(2) The Prince George's County Board of License Commissioners may approve the issuance or transfer of a license into the boundaries of the 21ST, 22ND, 24th, ~~or 25th~~ 25TH, 26TH, OR 27TH alcoholic beverages district provided any off-sale privileges of the license are permanently waived as long as the license remains within the boundaries of the district.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of Article 2B, [§ 53(k)] § 9-217(L) OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND shall remain effective until September 30, [1995] 1997 and, at the end of September 30, [1995] 1997, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, Article 2B, [§ 53(k)] § 9-217(L) shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act - Misbranded Food
