

Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments

551.

(d) (2) In this subsection, “criminal investigation” means inquiries into alleged criminal activities in violation of Article 27, §§ 286, 286A, 286B, 286C, 287, [and] 287A, 407, 408, 409, 410, AND 411 of the Code conducted by a law enforcement agency, a grand jury, or a State’s Attorney under Article 10, § 39A of the Code.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1995.

CHAPTER 528

(Senate Bill 659)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws – Travel Trailers – Length Limitations

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of the term “travel trailer” to include certain vehicles up to a certain length; clarifying language; and generally relating to the definition of travel trailers.

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

11–170.

(a) “Travel trailer” means a vehicle that:

(1) Is mounted on wheels;

(2) Is of such a size and weight as not to require any special highway movement permit when towed by a motor vehicle;

(3) Is designed and constructed primarily to provide temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use; and

(4) [Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, is] IS no longer than [35] 40 feet.
