

(6) SPECIFIC TERMS GOVERNING THE OPERATION OF THE AUTHORITY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO FINANCIAL REPORTING, BUDGETARY, AND PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS, PROVIDED THAT THESE SPECIFIC TERMS MAY NOT ADD POWERS TO THE AUTHORITY WHICH ARE NOT INCLUDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

~~(D)~~ (E) THE COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY HOWARD COUNTY SHALL SEND TO THE SECRETARY A COPY OF ANY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION ACTIVATING A QUASI-PUBLIC AUTHORITY WHICH WILL SERVE AS A CORE SERVICE AGENCY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1995.
