(A) A FAMILY IS POTENTIALLY ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE ONLY IF THE FAMILY INCLUDES:

- (1) A MINOR CHILD WHO RESIDES WITH A CUSTODIAL PARENT OR OTHER ADULT CARETAKER RELATIVE OF THE CHILD; OR
- (2) A PREGNANT INDIVIDUAL.

(B) ASSISTANCE SHALL BE PROVIDED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE ONLY IF THE APPLICANT FOR OR RECIPIENT OF ASSISTANCE:

(1) RESIDES IN THIS STATE AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION FOR THE ASSISTANCE;

(2) (I) HAS APPLIED FOR CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES WITH THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT OFFICE AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION FOR THE ASSISTANCE; AND

(II) COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE LOCAL CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT OFFICE;

(3) HAS ENGAGED IN JOB SEARCH ACTIVITIES AS REQUESTED BY THE DEPARTMENT;

(4) PARTICIPATES IN WORK ACTIVITY UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, UNLESS EXEMPT UNDER CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE SECRETARY WHICH SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING GROUPS OF INDIVIDUALS:

(I) ADULTS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO CARE FOR A CHILD WHO IS A RECIPIENT UNDER AGE 1;

(II) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, ADULTS AND CHILDREN WHO ARE RECIPIENTS AND WHO ARE SEVERELY DISABLED; AND

(III) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, CHILDREN 16 YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER WHO ARE NOT IN SCHOOL AND WHO ARE SEVERELY DISABLED; AND
