

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

- (2) transfer the Office of and Commission on Common Ownership Communities to the Office of Consumer Affairs;
- (3) make technical, clarifying, and stylistic changes; and
- (4) generally amend County laws regarding the administration of programs involving landlord-tenant relations and common ownership communities.

Laws of Montgomery County, 1995

AN EMERGENCY ACT to:

- (1) transfer certain solid waste functions from the Department of Environmental Protection to the Department of Transportation;
- (2) make technical, clarifying, and stylistic changes in the County solid waste law;
- (3) clarify the process by which certain solid waste charges and fees are set; and
- [[(3)]] (4) generally amend the law governing the administration of County solid waste collection, disposal, and recycling programs.

Chapter 48, Solid Wastes
Sections 48-1, 48-3, 48-8A, 48-19, 48-24, 48-29, 48-31, 48-32, and 48-42
