

**CHAPTER 514**

**(House Bill 1054)**

AN ACT concerning

**Carroll County – Alcoholic Beverages  
(License Renewal Late Fees)**

FOR the purpose of providing that in Carroll County any alcoholic beverages licensee who fails to renew the license may be charged a late fee by the Board of License Commissioners; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Carroll County.

BY adding to

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
Section 10-301(q)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1996 Replacement Volume)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

10-301.

(Q) IN CARROLL COUNTY THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY IMPOSE A LATE FEE OF \$50 PER DAY FOR EACH DAY A LICENSEE FAILS TO RENEW THE LICENSE AFTER THE APPLICATION IS DUE. THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THE FEES MAY NOT EXCEED \$500.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.

**CHAPTER 515**

**(House Bill 1083)**

AN ACT concerning

**~~Life and Health~~ Life and Health Insurance and Annuities ~~Annuity Contracts~~ Annuities –  
Rebates**

FOR the purpose of prohibiting persons from offering, promising, or giving any valuable consideration not specified in a contract of life or health insurance or an annuity contract, with certain exceptions, regardless of whether a policy is purchased; ~~providing a certain exception for contracts of insurance other than life and health insurance and annuities;~~ and generally relating to rebates on ~~contracts of life and~~
