

(16) SHALL PROVIDE SUCH PERSONNEL, AUTOMATION, AND TECHNOLOGY AS ARE NECESSARY TO ALLOW THE LICENSED PHARMACIST EMPLOYEE TO COMPLY WITH THE LABELING REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIED IN § 12-505.

[(b)](C) (1) The Board may waive any of the requirements of this section for the University of Maryland School of Pharmacy, for [radio] NUCLEAR pharmacy and dental pharmacy experimental and teaching programs.

(2) The Board may waive the requirements of subsection [(a)(4)] (B)(5) and [(5)] (6) of this section for pharmacies that are engaged in pharmaceutical specialties which are recognized by the Board under rules and regulations adopted by the Board.

(D) A NONRESIDENT PHARMACY SHALL HOLD A PHARMACY PERMIT ISSUED BY THE BOARD.

(E) (1) IN ORDER TO OBTAIN A PHARMACY PERMIT FROM THE BOARD, A NONRESIDENT PHARMACY SHALL:

(I) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES;

(II) PAY TO THE BOARD AN APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD;

(III) SUBMIT A COPY OF THE MOST RECENT INSPECTION REPORT RESULTING FROM AN INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY THE REGULATORY OR LICENSING AGENCY OF THE STATE IN WHICH THE NONRESIDENT PHARMACY IS LOCATED; AND

(IV) ON THE REQUIRED PERMIT APPLICATION, IDENTIFY THE NAME AND CURRENT ADDRESS OF AN AGENT LOCATED IN THIS STATE OFFICIALLY DESIGNATED TO ACCEPT SERVICE OF PROCESS.

(2) A NONRESIDENT PHARMACY SHALL REPORT A CHANGE IN THE NAME OR ADDRESS OF THE RESIDENT AGENT IN WRITING TO THE BOARD 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE CHANGE.

(F) A NONRESIDENT PHARMACY SHALL:

(1) COMPLY WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE IN WHICH IT IS LOCATED;

(2) ON AN ANNUAL BASIS AND WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER A CHANGE OF OFFICE, CORPORATE OFFICER, OR PHARMACIST, DISCLOSE TO THE BOARD THE LOCATION, NAMES, AND TITLES OF ALL PRINCIPAL CORPORATE OFFICERS AND ALL PHARMACISTS WHO ARE DISPENSING PRESCRIPTIONS FOR DRUG, OR DEVICES, OR ~~DIAGNOSTICS~~ TO PERSONS IN THIS STATE;

(3) COMPLY WITH ALL LAWFUL DIRECTIONS AND REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION FROM THE REGULATORY OR LICENSING AGENCY OF THE STATE IN WHICH IT IS LOCATED AND ALL REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION MADE BY THE BOARD PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION;
