

Annotated Code of Maryland
(1994 Volume and 1996 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 347 of the Acts of 1996

SECTION 15. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That subject to the approval of the Director of the Department of Legislative Reference, the publishers of the Annotated Code of Maryland shall correct any cross-references that are rendered incorrect by this Act.

Chapter 349 of the Acts of 1996

SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

(a) Pursuant to the plan of reorganization that is proposed by this Act, the publishers of the Annotated Code of Maryland, subject to the approval of the Maryland Department of Legislative Reference, shall propose the correction of any agency names and titles throughout the Annotated Code that are rendered incorrect by this Act.

(b) To the extent necessitated by this Act, the Department of Legislative Reference, in conjunction with the publishers of the Annotated Code, shall revise the Annotated Code of Maryland in order to conform the Code to the abolishment of the Department of Personnel and its administrative reorganization and merger into the Department of Budget and Management, and the transfer of the telecommunications components from the Department of General Services to the Department of Budget and Management as required under this Act, and this statutory revision shall be ratified by passage of the Annual Corrective Bill of 1997.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions
