STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF ELECTION LAWS

ANNAPOLIS, MARYLAND

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 23-11 of Article 33 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the State Administrative Board of Election Laws does hereby certify that at the General Election held in Garrett County on November 5, 1996, an Act known as Chapter 470 of the Acts of 1996 (House Bill 628, Question A) was submitted to the voters of Garrett County in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 470 of the Acts of 1996, said Act being as follows:

AN ACT concerning

**Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Sunday Class B and C Sales)**

FOR the purpose of providing for Sunday sales of certain alcoholic beverages in Garrett County under certain circumstances; specifying the terms and conditions of the sales; establishing a certain fee; providing for a local referendum and an effective date; making stylistic changes; requiring the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Garrett County to carry out certain duties; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Garrett County.

And it is hereby certified that at said election, 135 votes were cast for the adoption of said Chapter 470 in Election District 11 and Election District 15 and 97 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 470 in Election District 11 and Election District 15, the said Chapter 470 of the Acts of 1996 has therefore been ratified in Election District 11 and Election District 15.
