

Constitution, a candidate for elective office as a judge, or a judicial appointee as defined in Maryland Rule 16-814 is governed by § 15-610 of this subtitle.

(c) (1) An individual who is a public official only as a member of a board or who is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Maryland Health Care Foundation established under § 2-501 of the Health - General Article and who receives annual compensation that is less than 25% of the lowest annual compensation at State grade level 16 shall file the statement required by subsection (a) of this section in accordance with § 15-609 of this subtitle.

(2) A MEMBER ~~OR EMPLOYEE~~ OF THE HARFORD COUNTY LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD SHALL FILE THE STATEMENT REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 15-609 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(d) A commissioner or an applicant for appointment as commissioner of a biconity commission shall file the statement required by subsection (a) of this section in accordance with Subtitle 8, Part III of this title.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1999.

CHAPTER 415

(House Bill 381)

AN ACT concerning

Security Guards - Certifications and Renewals

FOR the purpose of requiring an applicant for certification as a security guard to be of good moral character and reputation; establishing a renewal process for certifications of security guards; requiring certification cards to contain the date on which the certification expires; authorizing the Secretary of State Police to refuse to renew certifications under certain circumstances; authorizing the Secretary of State Police to take certain disciplinary action if an applicant or individual pleads guilty or nolo contendere to or is convicted of certain crimes; and generally relating to certifications and renewals of certifications of security guards.
