OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LANDOVER HILLS, MARYLAND ENLARGING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF LANDOVER HILLS BY ANNEXING LAND CONTIGUOUS AND ADJOINING THE EXISTING CORPORATE AREA OF THE TOWN OF LANDOVER HILLS LOCATED ALONG 70TH AVENUE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH THORNWOOD STREET KNOWN AS 4105, 4106, 4107, 4108, 4109, 4110, 4112, 4114 AND 4116 70TH AVENUE, LANDOVER HILLS, MARYLAND AND THE LANDOVER AQUATIC CLUB, CONSISTING OF 4.027+ ACRES, SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS CONTAINED IN THE PETITIONS AND CONSENTS TO ANNEXATION SUBMITTED BY THE OWNERS OF PORTIONS OF THE ANNEXATION AREA
