AN ACT revising Title 11 and Title 20 of the Howard County Code; reorganizing provisions of the Code governing the Department of Finance and taxes, charges, and fees; repealing obsolete provisions; amending provisions for payment of certain taxes and charges by credit or debit card; altering provisions of the Water/Sewer Connection Financing Program; providing for the semiannual payment of property taxes; making stylistic and conforming changes; and generally relating to a revision of the provisions of the County Code governing the Department of Finance and taxes, charges, and fees.

AN ACT to:

[[(1) limit the purchase, sale, transfer, possession, and transportation of certain firearms and ammunition with respect to minors or within 100 yards of places of public assembly; and]]

(1) allow [[an]] certain existing gun [[shop]] shops within 100 yards of places of public assembly to continue operation under certain circumstances; and

(2) generally amend County law regarding weapons.
