8-107. SAME — MEMBERSHIP; TERMS.

(A) MEMBERSHIP.

THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 11 MEMBERS:

- (1) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;
- (2) THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES;
- (3) THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT; AND
- (4) THE FOLLOWING EIGHT MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE:

(I) TWO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WHO ARE NOT DIRECTLY EMPLOYED IN THE FIELD OF CORRECTIONS;

(II) TWO CORRECTIONAL PERSONNEL FROM STATE GOVERNMENT;

(III) TWO CORRECTIONAL PERSONNEL FROM LOCAL GOVERNMENT;

(IV) ONE OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF A NATIONAL CORRECTIONAL ACCREDITATION ORGANIZATION; AND

(V) ONE ELECTED OFFICIAL FROM A LOCAL GOVERNING BODY.
