(Charter Amendment: 1999 Annexation - 2nd Addition)

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND, ENLARGING THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HAVRE DE GRACE BY ANNEXING LAND CONTIGUOUS AND ADJOINING THE EXISTING CORPORATE AREA OF THE CITY OF HAVRE DE GRACE LOCATED BETWEEN CHAPEL ROAD AND CSX RAILROAD TRACKS ADJACENT TO BAYVIEW ESTATES AND THE WOODS AT BAYVIEW, AND CONSISTING OF 384.594 ± ACRES, MORE COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE WEBER FARM, THE FEJFAR PROPERTY AND THE ISHAK PROPERTY, ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE XI-E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND AND THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1957 EDITION AND AMENDMENTS THERETO) TITLED "CORPORATIONS-MUNICIPAL"; AND TO AMEND THE APPENDIX OF THE CHARTER OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF HAVRE DE GRACE, MARYLAND, BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION A.16., ENTITLED "THE 1999 2nd ADDITION TO THE CITY BOUNDARIES", ENLARGING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF HAVRE DE GRACE.
