

(i) notify the carrier at least 90 days before the date of termination;
and

(ii) for at least 90 days after the date of the notice of termination, continue to furnish health care services to an enrollee of the carrier for whom the provider was responsible for the delivery of health care services prior to the notice of termination.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2001.

CHAPTER 158

(Senate Bill 518)

AN ACT concerning

Election Law – Political Action Committees – Contributions

FOR the purpose of ~~authorizing a political action committee sponsored by or affiliated with another entity or group to collect contributions paid voluntarily by members when the member makes payment for membership dues or makes payment for contributions to a political action committee established under federal law; authorizing a political action committee that is sponsored by or affiliated with an entity or group of an affiliated entity to collect contributions that are paid voluntarily by its members by means of payroll deductions, together with the payroll withholdings from the employee employees that are made for the payment of dues by the members to the affiliated entity or group; under certain circumstances; authorizing a political action committee to have the combined voluntary contributions by members of an affiliated entity collected by the affiliated entity in conjunction with the receipt of membership dues or the voluntary contributions made to a political action committee established under federal law under certain circumstances; requiring certain political action committees, affiliated entities, and employers to keep certain records relating to certain contributions that are made by payroll deduction to political action committees under certain circumstances; prohibiting certain practices concerning solicitations for contributions to political action committees; and generally relating to certain contributions to political action committees.~~
